As the response received form M/s Hanu Reddy real estate was not up to our expectation in the Trust Meeting held on 5.6.2016, it was decided to give Advt on our own in English and Tamil News paper yiz Hindu and Dinamalar, and also sent SMS to all Accounts Personal Indicating our offer price. In response to our News Paper Advt. the offer recived were placed in the Trust meeting held on 31.07.2016

The meeting unanimously decided to sell the AFSOA House for Rs. 24.5 lakhs. Though all the Trustees have Putin considerable energy and efforts for the sale of AFSOA house the role played by shi V.Sivasamy, Sethu, Satyamoorthy, Jayapraksah, Dakshiamoorthy and Sriram deserve special mentio here.

NEW DELHI TRIP

Very few members may be aware that a welfare Trust was formed by AFSSOA at CHQ level Delhi in the AIC held at Calcutta in April 2002 and even trustees were announced. But no follow up action has been taken for the reasons best known to CHQ office bearers. In the AIC held at Guwahati in Nov 2003, it was decided to conduct a mini AIC to discuss and decide on the utility of funds/Asset with CHQ. That was also not done by the G.S. Hence in the Trust meeting held on 7.2.2016 and 31.07.2016 it was decided to visit N.Delhi to pressurise shri K.Satyanarayana to conduct mini conference and to get a reasonable Fund from CHQ to our welfare Trust as Tamilnadu is the only circle having Trust and doing charitable activities. Before departing to Delhi, Shri K.Balasubramanian contacted almost all ex.circle secretaries of AFSSOA, and requested them to attend the proposed meeting to be held at Delhi on 7.10.2016.

Gujarat and Rajasthan circle responded to our Request. All the CHQ office bearers stationed at N.Delhi attended the meeting. On 7.10.2016 a meeting was arranged in the Conf Hall of MTNL, Delhi. Shri H.C.Sharma our ex.AI President of AFSSOA presided over the meeting. In all 20 persons attended the meeting. Shri K.Satyanarayana informed the members that Roughly Rs.45/= lakhs are available in the AFSSOA Account both in SB and fixed deposits as at the end of 2011 and this include sale of AFSSOA Flat at Delhi. But the accounts were inoperative for a long time, first action is to be taken to revive the account and he promised to do that before 31.10.2016 and Sathyanarayana assured to conduct the Mini Conference in the month Feb or March 2017. Even after repeated phone call from Balasubramanian, Santhakumar, Hariharan & Sivakumar no initiative appears to have been taken by Shri Sathyanarayana to conduct the Mini conference. This August body can deliberate and give direction as to what further then action can be taken in this regard.

Sad demise of shri V.Sivasamy

The sudden and untimely demise of Shri V.Sivasamy our managing Trustee on 23.06.2016, was shocking. He was active in all the activities of the Trust. It was because of his devotion and dedication the Trust deed was successfully Registered on 10.02.2014 which was appreciated by one and all in the last AGB. His commitment towards the activities of the Trust are unparalleled. Though he is not physically present, he will remain in our heart and mind for ever for all the services rendered.

Shri K.S.Jayavelu the Veteran AFSSOA leader also breathed his last during this period. We all pray to the almighty to let their soul be rest in peace.
